Jesus Finished the Grave

## Luke 24:1-12

### 1. Remember, He's Alive

- Luke 24:5-8
- **Reality Statement:** Whenever you're afraid, sad, confused, upset, etc. remember what Jesus has already said.
- John 6:63
- **Frustrating Statement:** We're prone to forget.

### 2. Tell Somebody, He's Alive

- Luke 24:9-10
- **Quote:** "To be a soul winner is the happiest thing in the world. And with every soul you bring to Jesus Christ, you seem to get a new heaven here upon earth." - Charles Spurgeon
- **Quote:** "The best news of the Christian gospel is that the supremely glorious Creator of the universe has acted in Jesus Christ's death and resurrection to remove every obstacle between us and himself so that we may find everlasting joy in seeing and savoring his infinite beauty." - John Piper
- **Reality Statement:** The gospel is not good advice to consider, the gospel is good news to believe.

### 3. Marvel, He's Alive

- **Quote:** "We live and die; Christ died and lived!" - John Stott
- Luke 24:11-12
- **Good News Statement:** The resurrection teaches us Jesus is the God of the second chance.
- It should make us "marvel" = "something that causes great wonder, admiration, or astonishment"
  - (Dictionary.com) to express astonishment (verb)
  - to become filled with surprise, wonder, or amazed curiosity (Webster's)
- Romans 10:9
- **Quote:** "A dead Christ I must do everything for; a living Christ does everything for me." - Andrew Murray

# Charge Groups

## WHY WE GATHER IN COMMUNITY

💡 Remind the group of why we gather (To experience the presence of God & the building-up of one -another)

*Love one another: just as I have loved you... - John 13:34-35*

## ENCOURAGE THE GROUP

💡 Spend some time encouraging the group. Use this icebreaker question to laugh, enjoy one-another and look for opportunities to encourage. You can also begin by simply sharing one-high and/or one-low of the week.

**Icebreaker ?** *If you could witness any moment in history live, what would it be - and why?*

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## PRAYER & DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

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💡 **Facilitator:** Open the discussion time by sharing the purpose of Sunday's message OR share your most memorable part of the message. Spend time reading the scriptures on page 1 & discussing.

**1. Remember, He's Alive (Luke 24:5-8)** The angels told them to remember what Jesus said.

- Why do you think we're so prone to forget truth in hard moments?
- What is something Jesus has said (Scripture, promise, truth) that you need to actively remember right now?

**2. Real Life Application (John 6:63)**

- When fear, confusion, or frustration hits, what do you typically turn to first?
- How would your reactions change if you consistently remembered that Jesus is alive and His words are life?

**3. Tell Somebody, He's Alive (Luke 24:9-10)**

- The women immediately went and told others. What holds us back from sharing the gospel today?
- Who is one person in your life you could intentionally share your faith story with this week?

**4. The Gospel is Good News (Romans 10:9)**

- The Gospel is not good advice but good news. What's the difference?
- How does believing this change how you live daily (not just think spiritually)?

**5. Marvel, He's Alive (Luke 24:11-12)**

- Peter "marveled." When was the last time you were genuinely in awe of Jesus?
- What causes us to lose that sense of wonder over time?

## NEXT STEPS

💡 Encourage each other to take next steps based on the discussion. If something specific comes up, support one another in moving forward. Before ending, spend time praying for one another, asking the Holy Spirit for guidance. You may feel led to pray for a specific person or situation. If there's a practical next step, like baptism or joining the family, encourage each other to follow through.
